**Adrian Hsieh** is a sophomore in the dual Spanish immersion program at Corvallis High School. He began his piano studies at the age of five with Rebecca Jeffers and is currently a student of Dr. Alexandre Dossin at the University of Oregon. He has participated in many musical activities including various Oregon Music Teachers Association festivals, fundraising events, community services, summer camps, and chamber music programs. In 2018, he and his sister represented Oregon to compete in the Music Teachers National Association Northwest Division as a piano duet team. He placed 3rd in the 2016 Suzanne Raines scholarship competition and has played for Natasha Paremski in a masterclass in 2019. In addition, Adrian also studies cello with Dr. Steven Pologe at the University of Oregon. He placed 1st in the Oregon Mozart Players Young Soloist Competition in 2016, 2nd in the 2018 Eugene Symphony Guild Young Artist Competition, 1st in the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra Concerto Competition, and 2nd in the cello division in the Oregon School

Activities Association Solo Music State Championships in 2019. He has played in masterclasses taught by Zuill Bailey and Robert Jesselson, and has performed as a soloist with the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra in Vancouver, B.C., University of British Columbia Chamber Orchestra, the Oregon Mozart Players and the Corvallis-Oregon State University Symphony Orchestra. He is currently working on a project with a local Latino organization to involve more Latino students in music beyond the elementary string programs. Besides music, Adrian enjoys involving himself in theater productions and playing *Magic: the Gathering* with his sister.
