



### **Darrell Hunt, soloist**

Concertmaster of the Oregon Sinfonietta since the 2009 – 2010 season, Mr. Hunt is honored to make his second appearance as soloist. His first was on November 3, 2013 in which he performed Sibelius' *Violin Concerto in D minor, Op. 47* to the enjoyment of all.

At the age of twelve Mr. Hunt began playing the violin, and within four years performed a Bach concerto with the Southwest Washington Youth Symphony in Longview, Washington, his hometown. Mr. Hunt holds degrees from the University of Puget Sound in Tacoma, Washington, where he studied with Edward Seferian, and from Rice University in Houston, Texas, where he earned a Master of Music in

Vocal Performance while also playing under the baton of Larry Rachleff. Mr. Hunt has served as Assistant Concertmaster of the Tacoma Symphony, as well as Concertmaster and Principal player at the Spoleto Festival in Charleston, South Carolina. He has performed as a soloist and orchestral musician throughout the Northwest, as well as in Houston, Dallas, and Puerto Rico. Mr. Hunt is a prominent violin and voice teacher in the Portland/Vancouver area and lives in Wilsonville with his wife, Wendy, and two sons, Noah and Aaron.
